Fundraising starts as WEC gets go ahead to build Extension!

Alhamdulillah! Following East Renfrewshire Council's historic approval last year, of our planning permission application to extend the community facility, building warrants have now been granted for erecting a major two-storey extension on the upper car park (adjacent to the existing WEC building). Copies of the building warrants are available from WEC Reception, for public inspection.

WEC is indebted to the local Muslim and wider community and our local elected representatives who kindly advised on, and supported our planning application. The fundraising target is £500,000, and we plan to start construction as soon as required funds are in place in sha Allah. Copies of up-to-date charity accounts are available from the WEC Office.

The extended centre will provide a wider range of facilities to accommodate the growing religious, educational and social needs of our local community, including a much needed Nursery in the area. There is also an urgent need to expand existing WEC capacity to accommodate the growing number of daily WEC Quran, iSyllabus & Islamic studies classes for Children & Ladies, Mother & Toddler group, after-School SQA Tutoring, Interfaith and Dawah events, Sports clubs, Health awareness and Family Fun days, in addition to weekly Friday Jumah, and Ramadhan Taraweeh programmes.

The Trust has designed a beautiful and iconic new extension building (plans are available at WEC Reception), which will aim to serve as East Renfrewshire's first Islamic Eco-Community Centre, to accommodate around 1,000 users, with its low carbon footprint and eco-friendly design.

The new/extended facility will be a major addition to the 'green architecture' in Scotland and the UK. The design for the WEC extension facility will blend the characteristics of existing buildings in the neighbourhood, along with a number of sustainable eco-friendly architectural features.

Access to the site will be solely from Robeslee Road, closing off Burns Grove to prevent access from Inglestone Avenue. This is intended to prevent any increase in traffic on this side of the site and avoid disruption to local residents. Alongside the community hall extension, there will be extended car park spaces, which will be made freely available to local school parents for pickup and drop off. This will help reduce congestion during peak traffic hours.

Please continue to play your part in this sadaqa jariya (continuous charity) project for our coming generations, by

supporting the WEC extension fund- raising appeal, and build your house in Jannah in sha Allah!

Project outcomes:

CO2e:

- 🚲 Targeting 500 regular community users, through a focus on household waste reduction, by promoting reduction, reuse and recycling (3 R's), to reduce landfill waste and overconsumption.
- 🚲 Cut CO2e through 12 community members who have completed extensive cycle training and adopted cycling as their main mode of transport to/from WEC.

Community:

- 🚲 Behavioural change and upcycling through innovatively themed workshops of 500 WEC community users network, leading to less waste going into landfill.
- 🚲 Four interactive digital stories to aid in educating and engaging the targeted BME community.
- 🚲 Reduce the amount of cars being driven to the Centre through a change in travel behaviour: targeting 30 regular community users per week, to exchange their cars for alternative modes of transport to WEC.
- 🚲 The promotion of social walking clubs and public/bus transport over the 12-month period.
- 🚲 To have at least 5 members of the WEC community actively take a lead role and use WEC's vegetable plot by March 2018.

Our successful small grant funds for WEC community activities

We are pleased to announce in this past year we have successfully been awarded three pots of small grant funding:

- £400 Cycle Employer Friendly Workplace Grant, through Cycling Scotland, which allowed us to invest in lockers for our staff members who cycle to the centre.
- £4,576 Cycle Friendly and Sustainable Communities fund, through Cycling Scotland. We used this to deliver a 10 week cycle training session for adults, a 10 day children's Easter Cycle Camp & invest in more cycle infrastructure. We would like to thank our delivery partners Neilston Development Trust who allowed us to provide excellent training to our community.
- £1,250 CCF development grant used to carry out community consultation events including at Pizza night & surveys to gain your feedback. Thank you to those who attended & took part in the surveys we are processing your thoughts & feedback.
