## Purpose of the position:

This will be coupled with promoting new eco-friendly initiatives, through changing current travel behaviours via adoption of sustainable low-carbon transport choices, particularly monthly Cycle Skills Training and a focus on public transport, not only improving health but benefit the local economy in creating more vibrant, sustainable communities.

- Able to liaise/network with local organisations in a range of areas (workshop planning, community textile recycle bin, collecting community stories) to achieve project targets.
- Diplomacy is central to this role. The candidate will have experience of communicating and engaging with a range of BME and wider community on sustainability and climate change issues to drive our ambitions to deliver our climate change project goal.
